Palace tops out MorningStar

Palace Construction is building MorningStar Littleton, a new 71,100-square-foot, 85-unit assisted-living community. Lantz-Boggio Architects designed the \$20 million development, located at 5344 S. Kipling Parkway.

The community will have 65 assisted living units and 20 Alzheimer units. The building will open to residents in August 2006.

MacKenzie House is the developer. MacKenzie House also has two \$60 million continuing care campuses under development in Colorado Springs and Fort Collins. ▲
