A look inside local business

SENIOR HOUSING UNDER WAY

More senior housing is on the way to Colorado Springs.

Ground was broken last week on the \$72 million, 234-residence MacKenzie Place at Union, to be built on nearly 17 acres at the southwest corner of Union Boulevard and Fillmore Street.

The project, being developed by MacKenzie House LLC of Englewood, will include 65 independent-living cottages to be sold to residents; 95 independent-living apartments; and 74 assisted-living special-care units.

The first cottages are to be completed in June, while a main building that will house independent and assisted-living residences is scheduled to be finished in January 2008.
